AI IN ACADEMIC RESEARCH

In this month's newsletter, we look at Artificial Intelligence (AI) in the academic world. In April 2023 UNESCO developed a guide entitled "ChatGPT and Artificial Intelligence in higher education: quick start guide".

The Quick Start Guide introduces ChatGPT, an AI tool that has taken the world by storm, reaching 100 million users just two months after being launched.

The Quick Start Guide provides an overview of how ChatGPT works and explains how it can be used in higher education.

The Quick Start Guide also raises some of the main challenges and ethical implications of AI in higher education and offers practical steps that higher education institutions can take.

Some of the applications of ChatGPT discussed in the report as could be used in higher education included:

- research
- administration and
